Applications will be reviewed by Bucksport Arts Festival after the deadline. Artists will be notified of acceptance, and payment will be due at that time.

FESTIVAL INFORMATION

Application is not a guarantee of participation. Applications are due by May 1, 2018. All applications will be reviewed by the Festival Jury Committee. 50 spaces are currently available and artists will be notified of acceptance by May 15, 2018. Some artists may be placed on a waiting list and will be notified if a space becomes available at a later date.

How to Apply: Complete the online or printed application and submit to Bucksport Arts Festival before the deadline. Our committee will review all applications and will notify artists of acceptance. You must submit six digital images of the work you will display at the festival. Payment will be due within two weeks of acceptance. If accepted, artists will be required to pay a \$100 booth fee by June 1, 2018.

Vendor Types: Fine artists and craftspeople of all types are welcome to apply. Applicants must be the creator of the work being sold. No imports, resellers, or vintage/antiques will be accepted at this time. For more detailed information, please read our guidelines online.

Location: The festival will be located along the waterfront and on Main Street in Bucksport. The primary access points will be the public parking area across from the Post Office, the marina entrance near Camden National Bank, and the Municipal lot behind the Bucksport Town Office.

Booth Info: Each participant will be pre-assigned a 10' x 10' space. Each display must be a tent or canopy style, self supporting structure and must be capable of withstanding crowds and wind (the waterfront is windy!). You must provide tent weights of at least 25 lbs per leg. No electricity will be provided.

Set Up/Take Down: All set-up materials must be unloaded by 9am on Friday and vehicles moved to nearby parking areas. Booths should be set up by 10:00 am. Early departure is NOT allowed. All participants must display until 6pm both days.

Refunds/Cancellation: Artists may be refunded the registration fee prior to June 1st. No refunds will be issued after June 1, 2018.

Publicity: Participants may be included in promotional materials including posters, brochures, press releases, ads, BACAS website, and social media. We encourage all participants to further promote the festival and notify other artists of our event.

Information packets with booth location, maps, and other festival information will be sent by August 1st. Information will not be available prior to this date.
